## Safety on "re-entry" into fields after spraying

The LAMU has drawn up guidelines for the use of personal protective equipment (PPE) in fields at Agroecology (AGRO). The guidelines take effect as from May 2021 and **apply to everyone who walks** in fields at Foulum, Askov and Flakkebjerg.

The decision on requiring use of PPE was made based on internal trial data at AGRO Data show a risk of exposure to pesticides when you walk in fields that have been sprayed.

## Guidelines on use of PPE on re-entry in fields at AGRO after spraying

Walking in fields 1-7 days after	Minimum requirements for use of PPE
spraying	Dry crop:
In cases where the crop is wet from rain or dew, more severe requirements apply. See minimum requirements.	Short cotton gloves.

	Work clothing, rainwear, disposable one- piece suit or cotton boiler suit, which is changed when the work in the field is done.

## General request concerning clothes for work in the field:

It is recommended that everyone wears rubber boots/industrial footwear in the fields.

It is recommended that everyone wears work clothing and changes clothes at the end of the working day or when the work in the field is finished.
