

# The Plant agreements and economics

- Plant agreement (2023): 129 mio. dkk/year
  - Advice (59 mio.), participation, papers and reports requested under the work programme
  - Research (70 mio.), used for co-financing external funded research projects (these projects usually cannot cover the cost of infrastructure at AU - their OH is too low)

## Types of tasks

Tasks via "The good Request"  
- mainly tasks from the work programme

- Memorandums
- Reports
- Parliament questions
- Participation in conferences, committees, workshops, etc.

Ongoing tasks (in WP – without requests)


- Participation in working groups
- Surveillance task (fx air pollution)
- Collections (fx NordGen)

Tasks outside the Framework Agreement

- Add-ons to the Framework agreement (with extra resources)
- Bids (competition)
- Academic consultancy-projects

## Two possible entrances

- Scientific based consultancy for public and private sectors after submitting bid and in accordance with agreements (not Framework agreement) (*procedure 1*)
- Scientific based public sector consultancy financed by the Framework agreement (*procedure 2*)



## Quality Management System, scope



Tasks included:

Science-based policy advise under the Framework agreement *and* commissioned advise within the academic areas covered by the framework agreements\*:

- ✓ tasks (including allonges) commissioned by ministries
- ✓ advisory tasks (including income covered business tasks) for municipalities, companies, interest organisations, etc.




Tasks not covered:

- ≠ Tasks without academic assessment, e.g. pure analysis lab tasks
- ≠ Tasks funded by research councils, private foundations, research programmes (unless they are advisory tasks)

OBS:

- ! Reports published from TECH must be quality assured acc. to Procedure 7
- ! AU as sub-contractor: AU contribution must be quality assured
