Ad 3: Messages

A) Funding opportunities, Torsten:

Torsten went over the funding opportunities. This can be found at the funding website https://agro.medarbejdere.au.dk/projektstyring/ekstern-finansiering/.

Torsten encouraged to be aware of the EUopSTART funding possibilities. You can apply for part-funding of salaries, travel expenses and external assistance: 50,000 DKK for partner and 75,000 DKK for coordinators. Deadlines 18 May, subsequently 24 August and 2 November.

To coordinate the efforts and avoid too much competition in the different calls (e.g. ERANET and HEU) Torsten will organize a meeting in the department in two week time.

- Climate and Water has to come up with subjects for department seminar. Send proposals for topics to Jytte before 16 April.
- Corona restrictions: General regulations from AU requires that you have a negative test not older than 72 hours, if you are present in Foulum.
- Committee for field equipment: Jeroen informed that the group started on making an inventory of what equipment we have and where it is based. A lot of stuff is stored at Foulumgård, and one important task is to find out if any of this is still operative. The TDR equipment needs to be updated soon. If you have any questions, Jeroen can be contacted.
- There is a security problem in using Team-Viewer on the remote computers in the field and a new software has to be installed. It is allowed to use Team-Viewer if access can be granted by the user, but this is not the case on the remote computers in the field. Dennis Villadsen and Dennis Christensen are looking into this. The issue may also apply for other departments.
